Pursuant to the Bylaws of Stokes Partnership for Children, Inc., adopted August 1994, and amended May 16, 2002, the term of the Directors shall be as follows: The Board of Directors shall be divided into four classes. The First Class shall be composed of the positions as named in Article V, Section 2, which are elected or hired positions, and their terms shall not expire. The other three classes, referenced as Second Class, Third Class and Fourth Class, shall be composed of the remaining directors, including those required in Article V, Section 2, and each class is to be as nearly equal in number as possible. Directors in the second through fourth classes will be elected for terms of three years. Therefore, of the second through fourth classes, only one-third of the Board will be elected each year.
