APPLICATION PROCESS

Thank you for applying to the AmeriCorps and Children Together program. The following is a description of the applications process.

1. Submit your application to the ACT program office. All applications will be reviewed. Please send application to the following address.

2. If your application is approved, you will be invited to interview.
3. The Program Coordinator will conduct a preliminary interview with you. If you live less than 100 miles away from King, NC, the interview will be in person. If you live farther away, the interview will be conducted over the phone.
4. If it seems that you are a good match for the program, you will be asked to interview with the placement agencies in the various service counties. This interview may be held together with the preliminary interview depending on the circumstances.
5. If your interview is approved, you will need to complete the necessary paper work for a final acceptance. If accepted into the program, you will be reimbursed for the cost of these tests, screenings, and checks.
 - o Criminal Background Check (SBI for in state, FBI for out of state)
 - o Physical Exam
 - o Tuberculosis Test
 - o Drug Screening
 - o Copy of Drivers License
 - o Copy of Social Security
 - o Copy of Birth Certificate
 - o Copy of Diploma or GED
