What: The Dental Crisis Fund was set-up to meet the emergency dental needs of children from the ages of 5 to 18; to offer a supplemental fund for children in severe tooth pain and/or in need of emergent dental care.

Who Qualifies: Children who live in Stokes County, who are between the ages of 5 to 18, who do not receive Medicaid and who are not covered under any insurance plan or who are under insured.
