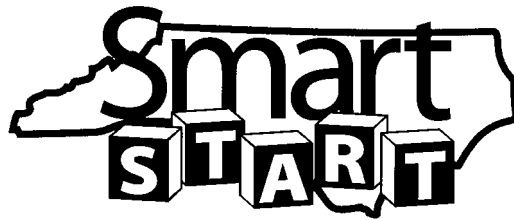

Since 1999, AMERICORPS AND CHILDREN TOGETHER (ACT) has been “Getting Things Done” for children in North Carolina. ACT combines the AmeriCorps national service program with North Carolina’s Smart Start initiative. ACT serves young children by placing AmeriCorps members in childcare settings as Early Childhood Education Assistants. The ACT program was designed to assist with the need for teacher education and the enhancement of quality childcare, for children 0 to 5. ACT does this by: 1) training AmeriCorps members in child development and early childhood education; 2) utilizing members as substitute teachers, thereby providing regular teachers/providers with release from the classroom to pursue coursework in early childhood education; and 3) utilizing members as assistant teachers as a means to reduce the high teacher-child ratios and provide additional resources to care providers.

The AmeriCorps members receive a modest living allowance for providing these services, and an Education Award. As well, the program provides tuition for ACT members to enroll in college courses and earn NC Early Childhood Credentials I & II.

Choosing Quality Child Care

If you are a parent who is seeking child care for a young child, choosing *quality* care is one of the most important decisions you will ever make for your child.

Some questions to consider:

Is the program licensed by the Division of Child Development or Nationally Accredited?

Do they have a Star Rating? 1 star facilities meet minimum licensing requirements. A 2—5 star rating means the facility meets higher program standards and higher staff education levels.

Ask about the training, education and experience of staff.

What is the program's philosophy?

Do they provide a safe and clean environment that ensures the health and safety of the children?

Is the staff interaction nurturing, warm and caring?

What is the staff to child ratio? Is it low enough so that there are enough staff to supervise all of the activities of the children?

Do they provide an age appropriate, fun learning environment that promotes the social, emotional, physical and intellectual development of children?

Is there an "open door" policy that encourages parent and family involvement?

Are there nutritious meals and snacks provided for the children?

“Free to Be Safe”

- Because there are no physical scars, children exposed to violence are often forgotten, or even ignored.
- Domestic violence happens in families of all social and economic levels.
- Domestic violence always gets WORSE, and can result in suicide or homicide.
- Children are present in half the homes where police are called because of domestic violence. Some have been abused.
- Children in violent homes feel responsible for the abuse, suffer constant anxiety or worry about being abandoned.
- They may experience cognitive or language problems, developmental delay, stress-related physical ailments and hearing and speech difficulties.
- Boys who witness domestic violence are more likely to batter their female partners as adults than boys raised in non-violent homes.
- Approximately 15 states have already passed legislation that presence of physical violence should affect child custody decisions.
- Children are either on the scene or directly involved in over 50% of documented domestic violence situations.
- Domestic violence hits ONE in THREE families in our country.
- Behavioral patterns learned by children in violent home situations affect their daily lives, often the adulthood.
- Children who try to prevent a parent from being battered are at a greater risk of being hurt themselves.
- Only ONE in TEN acts of domestic violence is ever reported.
- Family violence tends to be repeated over many generations.

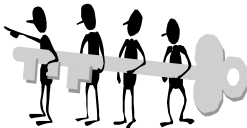

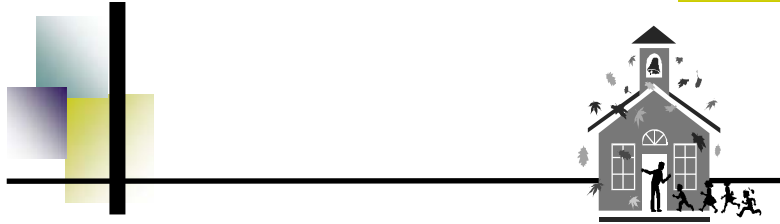

STOKES COUNTY PRESCHOOLS

The following preschool programs are located within the Stokes County School System:

- Exceptional Children's Program: This program serves children between the ages of 3 and 5 years that have been identified with delayed patterns of development in one or more of the following areas: physical, cognitive, communication, social/emotional, or adaptive development. Eligibility is based upon guidelines set forth by the NC Department of Instruction, Procedures Manual for Serving Children with Disabilities.
- More At Four Program: A state-funded program that provides educational experiences for young children. Eligibility is based upon *age and income guidelines set forth by the More At Four Office.
- Title I: A federal-funded program that provides educational experiences for young children. Eligibility for this program is based upon *age requirements and academic needs of young children.

Each classroom is a blended program serving children based upon the stated eligibility requirements. Pre-K Screenings, which help determine eligibility, are held each spring across Stokes County. Public announcements can be found in the local newspaper, on public radio, and other advertised areas.

*Age requirement: A child must be 4 years of age on or before October 16 of the current school year.

**Services for Pregnant Women
and Families with Children ages 0-5 years:**

“Baby Love”/Maternity Care Coordination: Caring support, information about pregnancy/ childbirth/ parenting, and help finding community resources. Meet with your Baby Love Worker once a month, at your convenience. Earn free items for your new baby! This service is free and available to all expectant families in Stokes County.

IF YOU’RE PREGNANT & SAY “YES” TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. I have questions about my pregnancy / childbirth
2. This is my first pregnancy
3. I would like someone to talk to and support me
4. I want to know how my community can help me
5. I need help getting ready for my baby

THE “BABY LOVE” PROGRAM IS FOR YOU!

“Baby Steps” Prenatal Classes: Series of 4 classes covering childbirth, newborn care, infant feeding, and infant growth & development. Attendance at all 4 classes in one month’s time earns participants a free infant car seat. Classes are offered 6 times per year in King and/or Danbury. Classes are free and available to all expectant families in Stokes County.

Post-Partum/Newborn Home Visit: Free home visit by a nurse to check health of mom and newborn including weight/height measurement and blood pressure check.

“Child Love”/Child Service Coordination: Caring support, information about parenting and child development, free developmental screenings for your child, and help finding community resources. Meet with your Child Love Worker once a month, at your convenience. Earn free items for your child! This service is free and available to all families in Stokes County with children aged 0-5 years of age.

IF YOUR FAMILY HAS CHILDREN AGED 0-5 YEARS OLD AND YOU CAN SAY “YES” TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. I have questions about parenting
2. I would like someone to talk to and support me

You don't stop being a person when you become a parent. We all have our own needs and interests, and deserve time to enjoy these things. By doing nice things for ourselves, we reduce stress and are better able to handle the demands of parenting. It will be easier to meet our children's needs when we have taken care of our own. You should take advantage of any free time as it occurs to fulfill your own needs. Use naptime to read, watch a favorite television show, soak in a warm bubble bath or chat with friends on the phone. When the children are at school or daycare, visit friends, go shopping or just relax.

the warning signs...

- 1. Feelings of loneliness and isolation**
- 2. Doubt, confusion or anxiety about your parenting skills**
- 3. Guilty feelings about the way you treat your child**
- 4. Negative thoughts about yourself or your children**
- 5. Recurring arguments or violence between you and your spouse**
- 6. Accumulated stress- financial, emotional, medical, etc.**
- 7. Memories of abuse from your childhood revived by your child's behavior or looks.**
- 8. Alcohol or drug abuse problems within the family.**

Together We Grow

North Carolina Early Intervention Services



The Winston-Salem Children's Developmental Services Agency (CDSA) is part of a state-wide early intervention program that serves children with developmental delays from birth to age 3. Anyone in the community, including parents, may refer a child if he is concerned about a child's developmental skills.

Concerns may include:

- Difficulty learning to sit or crawl
- Toddlers not walking or talking
- Problems with eating
- Medical conditions, including prematurity, that may affect skills
- Concerns about overall development

The Winston-Salem CDSA offers free evaluations and, for those who qualify, service coordination to assist a family with reaching their child's highest potential. The agency also provides service coordination to families whose babies who need to remain in the hospital following their birth. If you have questions about your child's development or would like to refer a child for services, please call our intake coordinator, Libby Hendrix, at 336-713-2412



YADKIN VALLEY HEAD START

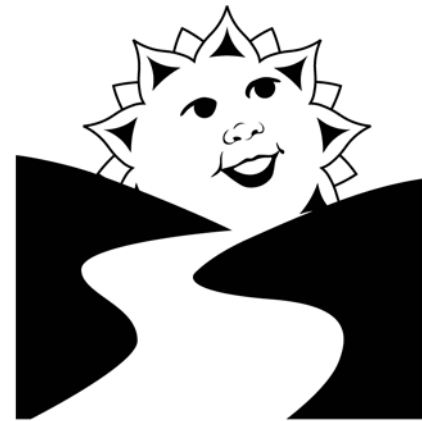

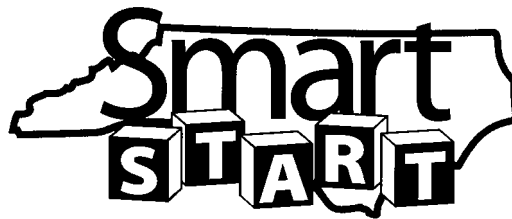
